Considering Ourselves with a View of God

As we travel this world, our journeys are truly full of excitement and growth. Especially when we have the right divine self-view. To have the right view, we must see God clearly, understand His word, and be boastfully humble.

- I. Ourselves with a view of God leads us to humility.
- A. Humble persons do not view themselves above others.
 - 1. Humility is actually a great quality, making one great. Act 20:19
 - 2. A humble servant is in God's view first, as a slave. 19
 - 3. A humble servant does not come to be served but to serve. 19
 - B. Humble servants imitate Jesus, give lives as an exchange. Mt 20:28
- II. Ourselves with a view of God leads us to not being deceived.
- A. One's view of God causes them to have the correct view of self. Gal 6:3
 - 1. Not think they're really something, but compared to God, nothing. 3b
 - 2. Else, a person is truly deceiving themselves, God is in control. 3c*
 - 3. Correct self-view is to be saved from wretchedness, a child. Mt 18:3a
 - 4. While we are saved as unworthy servants, we are also God's child.3b
 - B. We need to have an awareness that we are sinners saved? Ro 12:3
 - 1. Though Noah planted vineyard he sinned, became drunk. Ge 9:21
 - 2. Abram lied significantly about Sarai, his wife. Gen 12:11-13
 - 3. Isaac to Jacob: *Are you really my son Esau?* Said: *yes. Ge 27:21+*
 - 4. Moses spoke rashly with his lips and hit the rock. Ps 106:32-33
 - 5. Joshua noticed men taking some of enemy provisions. Jos 9:14+
 - 6. David, did some right things, but matter of Uriah the Hittite. 1Ki 15:5
 - C. We are not deceived as we recognize: *no condemn, but save.* Jn 3:17
 - D. We are created by God, living in a fallen world, seeing ourselves.
- III. Ourselves with a view of God leads us to a convinced boasting.
- A. View causes firm boast behavior: simplicity & godly sincerity. 2Cor 1:12
 - B. Our view of self and God rejects earthly wisdom, but not grace. 12c
 - C. Our view of self is that we are jars of clay, only boast in God. 2Cor 4:7
 - D. As jars of clay, we notice the surpassing divine power. 7b
 - E. In our minds/hearts we feel confused about: *dutiful unworthy servants.*
 - 1. When doing as ought, we still sing: *Amazing Grace* [wretch].Lu 17:10
 - 2. We are better because it keeps us from being deceived. Gal 6:3
