What an interesting word: health. Jesus seems to be involved in endless healing wherever He goes. And He goes with us daily. You find your needed purpose driven health, by getting healed on a daily basis.

I. Our need and desire to be seeking our calling of better health.

- A. Our lives reflect God's calling us to live today for Him. Rev 12:10
- B. While we seek God, we pray, healing, health come. Gen 20:17
- C. We walk in this world, we get wounds, but He binds. Job 5:18a
- D. We walk in our journeys, things shatter, His hands heal. 5:18b
- E. Our need to keep God's covenant to us, near our hearts. 1Sa 6:3
- F. Jesus' pact: "I am" living water, which brings healing. 2Ki 2:21
