Stewardship: Managing the Small, Norm, and Best

Various Scriptures

Our income and giving from it to God may be the most comprehensive aspect of our adult-life faith. To say the world revolves around the use of money contains much truth. So we consistently wrestle with this challenge.

I. Jesus watching giving patterns related to small gifts by faith.

- A. Jesus speaks about while managing your income/wealth beware of:
- 1. Giving to impress others for self-esteem purposes. Mk 12:38
- 2. Giving to get honor from this world above all else. 39
- 3. Giving for honor at the expense of others can be easily taken advantage of.
 - a. To devour for the sake of having wealth/money/income. 40a
 - b. The Greek word "katesthio" signifies: eating/ingesting down.
 - c. And so, this kind of giving is a small gift according to Jesus. 40a
- B. Jesus speaks/teaches about small giving as out of abundance. 43-44
- C. Jesus speaks/teaches about giving as out of poverty. 44b
- D. Poverty giving is about giving from what you have to live on. 44cd
- E. Poverty giving also can entail: putting in all you have [radical]. 44c


